



Life, Creatively Organized Top 10 organizing tips under \$10

Hí there! As a professional organizer, I want to help you organize your life and decorate your home for less, but I also want to show you how to do it inexpensively. So, here are my favorite organizing tips under \$10 that will help you get your home organized!



1. Keep scarves neat by <u>hanging them through shower curtain rings strung on a hanger.</u>
Both hangers and shower curtain rings can be purchased at the dollar store.



2. Cut down your empty food boxes to custom <u>organize your junk drawer</u> for free! Recycle and get customized organization for free – woot!



3. Cut down the side of a cereal box to <u>store plastic lids in kitchen cabinets</u>. Saves on storage space and it's free!



4. Use toilet paper tubes to <u>store electrical cords</u> neatly. (Free again – see the theme?)



5. Cut toilet paper tubes down one side. <u>Place on wrapping paper rolls</u> to keep the paper from unwinding.



6. Use a tackle box to store earrings. I sort mine by color. (under \$10)



7. Use Command hooks to <u>hang measuring cups and spoons on the inside of a kitchen cabinet</u> to keep them handy and free up drawer space.



8. Use a shoe bag with clear pockets hung over the door to <u>organize your linen closet</u>. Organize medicines, toiletries, and other items so they are easily accessible.



9. Hang a tension rod under the kitchen sink to <u>hang cleaning bottles</u>. (\$5)



10. Use 3 nails to tack an outgrown crib fitted sheet in the corner for a <u>no-sew stuffed toy</u> <u>hammock</u> to corral all those toys neatly. It holds a lot more than you think!
